

## POSTPONED SURVEYS.

Survey Due 2nd Special Survey No.3 due July, 1926 - Partly held.  
Boiler Survey due June, 1927 - Partly held.  
Six months' limit on centre furnace of starboard boiler ( to renew) expires October, 1927.

A proposal to complete the Special Survey within the year of grace was agreed to in September, 1926.

The Amsterdam Surveyors now state that the vessel is laid up at that port and that the above surveys will be attended to when she is again put in commission.

N.B. The Special Survey has been partly held on the machinery by the examination of the screwshaft, propeller, stern bush, sea connections and fastenings.
