Gentlemen,

I have to inform you that the Society's Surveyors at Dusseldorf recently forwarded certificates of test of bower anchors, chain cables and stream chain made by The Hochfelder Walzwerk, Actien-Verein and intended for Messrs. Blohm & Voss's S.S. No. 161. The weights of the bower anchors appeared to be in order and the bower chain cables, although slightly less in weight than required by Table 22, were approved by the Committee. The stream chain, however, was considerably lighter than required by Table 22, and the test certificate was not signed and the Surveyors at Dusseldorf were informed that the stream chain could not be approved.

A letter has now been received from The Hochfelder Walzwerk, Actien-Verein, of which I enclose a copy and also a copy of my reply thereto, and I have to authorise you to attend the reweighing of this stream chain and ascertain the exact weight, and report the result to this Office for the consideration of the Committee.
