SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

In a letter, dated 29th June, received from the Society's New York office, it is stated that this vessel has been sold to the Pennsylvania Shipping Co., of Philadelphia, who were obtaining bids for reconditioning & scrapping. When these were to hand, they would decide what would be done with her. Indications were, however, to the effect that the cost of reconditioning would be so excessive that she would be sold for scrap.

In a cablegram received from the New York Office, dated 21st July, it is stated that this vessel has now been sold to the Northern Metals Co., & has proceeded to Philadelphia for breaking up.
