Particulars of Casualty The 3rd Special Survey No. 1 became due in May, 1932.

The vessel has been laid up and the Owners furnished the usual undertaking.

The vessel was recently sold to Italian purchasers for breaking up purposes and proceeded from Libenik to Trieste after general examination by the Split Surveyor.

The Trieste Surveyors now state, in a letter dated 21st July, they are informed by Messrs. Cantiere Navale Scoglio Olivi, of Pola, that the work of demolition began on the 10th July.
