Nature of Survey


Condition

The class of this vessel is subject to Special Survey, equal to a Half Time Survey, being held at 4 & 8 years, and to 15 fathoms of stream chain being supplied.

The Manchester Surveyors now report the vessel has been examined in dry dock, the caulking overhauled, and the bottom & rudder recoated.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed, with fresh record of survey, subject as above.
