Dear Sirs,

Reverting to my letter of the 17th November last respecting the case of the s.s. "DAYBREAK" (your first entry report No. 72703) I have to inform you, with reference to the fee of all chargeable for the survey during construction of the hull of this vessel up to the time of transfer to private ownership, that this fee is the liability of Messrs. 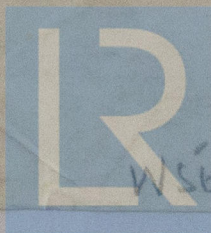
I shall therefore be glad if you will kindly see that the necessary entries are now made in your Rough Fee and Debit Books in the usual way.
