Reverting to your letters of the 21st October last and the 4th instant respecting the fees to be charged for the survey of the machinery made by Messrs. Richardsons, Westgarth Ltd., for the s.s. "DAYBREAK", your First Entry Report No. 15684, I have now to inform you that as the specification duties were carried out to the completion of the machinery in the Shops, the Standard fees at 1/4 per ton will be chargeable in this case. As the estimated gross tonnage of this vessel is 3054, the following fees will be chargeable, viz:-

For survey of Engines.....	£33:18: 8
" " " Boilers.....	16:19: 4

If the installation of the machinery has been carried out at your port a further fee of £12: 12: 0 will be chargeable.

You will, therefore, be good enough to render accounts accordingly.
