Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your freeboard report No. 72628 on the S.S. "DAYBREAK", Messrs. The Blyth Shipbuilding Co.'s No. 210, in which it is observed that the under-deck tonnage is appreciably greater than that reported for the two previous vessels "HAZELSIDE" and "DUNMAIL", and I have to request you will state whether in this case cargo battens are fitted and ceiling fitted throughout the tank top, as would appear from the report, in which case the tonnage co-efficient becomes greater than that of the previous sister vessels referred to. I therefore await your reply before the case is dealt with.
