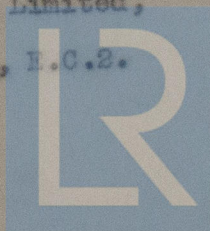
With regard to the other vessels enumerated in your letter, I may say that the Society's Surveyors had previously been instructed to give these cases the necessary attention.
