

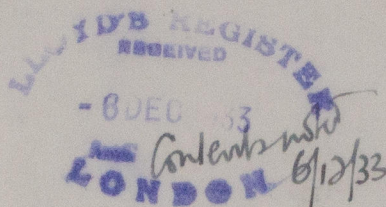

Dear Sir,

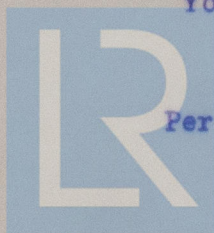
