### UNDERTAKING CASE

The 2nd Special Survey N° 3, which became due in February, 1932, has been partly held.

The vessel has been laid up & the Owners stated, in a letter dated 2nd March, 1933, that in view of the negotiations which were in hand regarding the sale of the vessel, they were unable to furnish the usual undertaking.

In a further letter received from the Owners, dated 26th September, it was stated that she had been sold to Messrs. J. Cashmore, Ltd., of Newport, Mon., for breaking up purposes.

The Newport, Mon., Surveyor now states, in a letter dated 11th January, 1934, he is informed by the new Owners that the work of demolition commenced on the 7th December last & will be finished in about a month's time.
