In reply to enquiry the Cardiff Surveyors now write that the vessel is still laid up at that port.

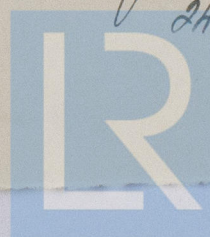
