

Steel turbine channel steamers Nos. 370 & 371, proposed to be built by Messrs. John Brown & Co., Ltd., of Clydebank, for the Fishguard & Rosslare Railways & Harbours Co. (Great Western Railway), with a view to class A1, "Awning deck, Irish Channel Service".

Rule dimensions ; 348.25 x 41 x 18.27

Equipment Number ; 31705.

It is desired by the Builders to supply the equipment to these vessels in accordance with the next lower grade of Table 22 of the Rules, it being urged that the vessels are of very fine form and have each three screws, and that they will therefore not be likely to be without adequate engine power in case of emergency.

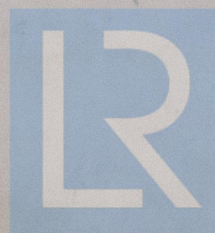
It appears that the Board of Trade have given their approval to the proposed equipment, and the Builders state that they are making this application with the concurrence of the Owners.
