I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 6th instant and verification of marking form in respect of the steamer "MUREX" and may say that particulars of the alterations effected have been inserted in the freeboard report.

In the circumstances I enclose herewith the Convention Freeboard Certificate and certified copy for issue.

It has been assumed that the closing appliance fitted to the tonnage opening in the after end of bridge is a portable steel plate secured by bolts which do not pass through the bulkhead plating and the certificates have been prepared accordingly. I shall be glad, however, if you will confirm this

with reference to the postscript to your letter, I shall be glad if you will render an account to the Owners for £5.5.0 in respect of the verification of the marking in this case.
