Steamers "PAKIPAKI" and "PIPIRIKI"

Dear Sir,

With reference to your letters "H" of 10th ultimo regarding the above vessels, we have to acquaint you that we have verbally been informed by Messrs Ditta Luigi Pittaluga, Vico Giannini 2, Genoa, that these two steamers have been purchased by them and that the "PIPIRIKI" is now laid up at this port. Also that the "PAKIPAKI" is under discharge at La Spezia and will be brought to Genoa to be laid up.

We have written to Messrs Pittaluga asking them to confirm this statement by letter and to let us know their intentions as to what will be done of these vessels.

An answer has not yet been received from the aforesaid Firm and we thought it well to inform you as to the position of these two vessels up to the present.
