Dear Sirs,

H. With reference to the Second Special Survey No. 3, which became due at the end of September last, and has been partly held on the machinery of the steamer "MARENGO", I have to acquaint you that in February last the Owners stated this vessel had been sold to Italian shipbreakers and the Committee agreed to the vessel proceeding, with a nonperishable cargo, to Italy, it being definitely understood that after arrival the vessel was to be broken up.

It would appear from the Shipping Papers the vessel left Venice on the 1st instant for Mon falcone, and in the circumstances I shall be glad if you will keep the case in mind and advise us immediately the work of demolition is commenced.
