It is observed that your survey will be continued on Tuesday next, when a full report will be forwarded, and in this connection I have to request that you will be good enough to transmit with your report a sketch of the fore part of the vessel giving in detail particulars of all the damage found and shewing the position of the stringers, beams, &c. at this part and the position and form of the fractures in the shell plating.

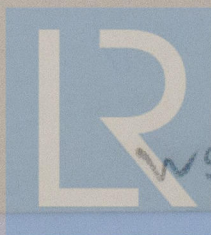
