Sir,

In accordance with instructions we beg to report that a survey has been held to-day by us on the Steamer "MARENGO" No. 813 in the R.B. whilst the vessel lay in the Alexandra Dry Dock.

Evidence of panting was observable in way of the Fore Hold, at the lower stringer, the 2nd plate from stem on the E Strake being fractured at the heel of the shell chock in the 5th space abaft the Collision Bulkhead on the Starboard Side, and in the 4th & 5th spaces abaft the Collision Bulkhead on the Port Side. A number of defective rivets were also found in the tank knee brackets in way of No. 1 hold.

Owing to the No. 1 tank and Peaks not being prepared for inspection we have been unable to complete our survey, but arrangements have been made to continue the same on Tuesday next when a full report will be forwarded.

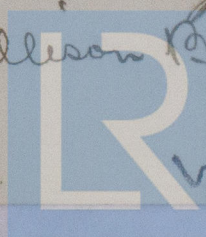
