I have telegraphed to Mr. Gilmour's private address, requesting him to proceed forthwith to Hull to join you in the inspection of the vessel.

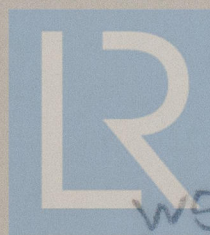
