
With reference to your note in the classing letter of the 16th instant regarding our reports on the "BERENGARIA" against the fee of £40. We have to say in reply that the fee was charged for the work carried out as a progressive survey of the hull, machinery and electric equipment as advised in our letter of 21st October.

Practically the whole of the machinery, tanks and electric equipment had been examined since 1934 against which no fee had been charged, and in view of the vessel being sold the matter was discussed with the Cunard White Star Officials who thought it reasonable that a fee for the work done should be paid.

In the circumstances the fee should be credited to our Annual Survey Reports since the last Special Survey.
