

QUADRUPLE S.S. "BERENGARIA".

Dimensions- 883.6 ft. x 97.96 ft. x 63.23 ft.

This vessel, formerly known as the "Imperator", was built by Messrs. Vulcan Werke at Hamburg in 1912, to the classification of the Germanischer Lloyd. She has now been acquired by the Cunard Steamship Company, who desire to class her with this Society.

The scantlings have been compared with those approved by the Committee in the case of the S.S. "AQUITANIA", a vessel of very similar dimensions, and it is found that the scantlings compare very favourably with the Committee's practice.

It is submitted that, upon a favourable report being received from the Society's Surveyors, the vessel will be eligible to be classed 100A-

It is stated that the anchors and cables will be ranged for examination at Southampton, and the question of the assignment of the figure "1" will be considered when the Southampton report is received.
