S.S. "Manx Isles."

We are in receipt of your letter of the 30th ultimo regarding the above Vessel and note all you write.

This Vessel is at present being used as a store ship, and all the work the boilers have to do is to supply steam to the cargo pump, the pressure on the boilers seldom being over 120 lbs.

Our requirements for having a depot ship will be completed in two or three months, and as we do not intend to re-commission the Vessel afterwards we should be glad if you could see your way clear to allow us to defer the survey on the main boilers.

We may state that both main boilers have recently been cleaned and reported by the Engineer to be in good condition.

Our intention is to dispose of the Vessel either for breaking up or for further service as soon as our tanks now being erected in Havre are completed.
