Dear Sirs,

S. With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the steamer "MANX ISLES", I beg to remind you that to complete the Boiler Survey, which became due in April of last year, and was partly held in March 1928, the survey of the auxiliary boiler required to be held.

The Committee have had the case before them at their meeting to-day and, in view of the intimation made by your Superintendent that the auxiliary boiler of this vessel is not now used, a notation of B.S. 3,28 has been assigned subject to this boiler not being used until it has been surveyed and satisfactorily reported upon by the Society's Surveyors.

You will observe that a complete Boiler Survey again became due at the end of last March.

I may add that the vessel's class is also subject to some repairs to the engines being carried out before the vessel proceeds to sea.
