Dear Sirs,

With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your steamer "MANX ISLES", I beg to acquaint you that a report was received from the Society's Surveyor at New Orleans in June last relative to damage sustained through grounding. The Surveyor recommended that the bottom plating, floors etc should be repaired on the termination of the vessel's voyage via Cuba.

As regards the Annual Boiler Survey, which became due in April last, I may say that this inspection has been partly held and that to complete the same the survey of the auxiliary boiler requires to be carried out.

It would appear from the Shipping Papers that this steamer is at present lying at Havre, and in the circumstances I shall be much obliged if you will kindly let me know for the information of the Committee, what arrangements you propose making for the above matters to

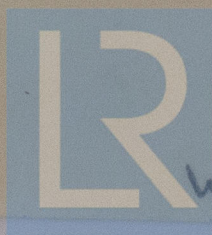
