In reply to your classing letter of the 1st inst respecting the steamer "Grewinnard" Rwe. Rpt. N° 74078, I beg to advise you that the upper deck beams are bulb angles, the scantlings of the forecastle deck & bulkheads at ends of vessel are as approved, a Downton pump is fitted to the holds etc, the construction of the bulkheads & tunnel is satisfactory, the requirements of Section 48 of the Rules have been complied with and that the length of the forecastle is 55 feet.

It is regretted that these items were not clearly stated on my report.
