SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

NIEMEN.—Danzig, Oct. 1.—The owners of the Polish steamer Niemen report that the vessel has been run down and sunk by unknown vessel in Skagerrak.

Gothenburg, Oct. 1.—Wireless information received states that the Polish steamer Niemen has been in collision with the Finnish barque LAW-HILL. Former vessel abandoned at sea; crew brought in here by Swedish motor vessel Kronprinsessan Margareta. LAW-HILL put in here leaky, bows damaged by collision.

NIEMEN.—Gothenburg, Oct. 1.—Salvage steamer Harald has been sent out to search for the steamer Niemen. — "Göteborgs Handels och Sjöfarts Tidning." (See issue of Oct. 3.)

NIEMEN.—Helsingborg, Oct. 2.—Salvage steamer Harald returned to her station at Gothenburg yesterday as it was evident that the steamer Niemen had sunk. — "Helsingborgs Dagblad."

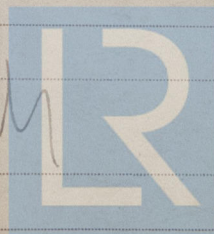
NIEMEN.—Copenhagen, Oct. 5.—Two aircraft, which were sent to the Skaw to mark the wreck of the steamer Niemen, returned here yesterday, having ascertained that the wreck was not visible. It may be concluded that it forms no danger to navigation. — "Dagens Nyheder."
