Dear Sirs,

With reference to the entry in the List of Limitation Surveys relative to the steamer "NORMA" and to the Boiler Survey which became due on this vessel at the end of January last and has been partly held, I have to acquaint you that the Owners have informed the Trieste Surveyors that the boiler repairs will probably not be carried out as it is intended to sell the vessel for breaking up purposes at the end of her present voyage. Should the steamer not be sold, however, they intend to lay her up at Genoa, whither she is proceeding and carry out the repairs at that port.

In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will be guided accordingly, and let me know in due course how the matter stands, and I may say that to complete the Boiler Survey and entitle the vessel to the record B.S. 2,32 the starboard boiler requires to be scaled, further examined and repaired, and the safety valves of both main boilers to be adjusted under steam.
