

It is submitted that Messrs Brown M^cFarlane & Co^s L^d be informed that the fees charged in this country for the survey during construction of the engines for the ship No 190 building at Nagasaki, & for the engines & boilers for the ship No 190 will be taken account of in determining the fees to be paid at Nagasaki for the completion of the surveys of the machinery etc of the vessels.

With regard to the request by Messrs Brown M^cFarlane & Co^s L^d to be supplied with certificates that the work done has been satisfactory, it is submitted that separate letters might be sent to them stating that the Glasgow Surveyors have reported that the boilers for 190 vessel have been completed and tested by hydraulic pressure to their satisfaction & that the Newcastle Surveyors have reported that the Turbine Engines for No 190 vessel have been completed to their satisfaction. In each case the letter might state that the Nagasaki Surveyor has been duly advised of the reports made in this country. It will be advisable for a copy of the letters to Messrs Brown M^cFarlane & Co^s L^d to be sent to the Nagasaki Surveyor for his guidance.
