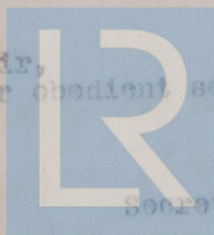
I enclose herewith for your information and guidance in dealing with the case a copy of Glasgow report No.25313 of survey held during construction on the boilers intended for the Turbine Steamer No.191 building by Messrs.The Kitsu Bishi Dockyard & Engine Works, and also a copy of Newcastle report No.52996 on the turbines for this vessel which have been shipped to the builders in Japan where the shafting, boilers and auxiliary machinery are to be fitted.

With regard to the fees in this case I have to acquaint you that if the whole survey had been completed in this country the fee for survey would be charged on a Nominal H.P.of $\frac{1}{2}(\frac{16800}{8} + \frac{37661}{12}) = 2970$, viz:- £168-10-0.

A fee of £48-10-0 has been charged by the Glasgow Surveyors for the survey of the boilers, and a fee of £50 is being charged for the survey of the turbine engines at Newcastle, and I have to request that you will charge a fee for the survey of the condensers and auxiliaries and for the survey of the erection on board.
