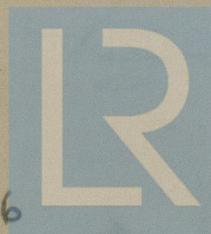
Further to my letter to you of the 7th July 1933 regarding the loss of the Steam Collier "CHRISTINA FRASER", have to advise you that the Commonwealth Marine Court of Inquiry finding yesterday was an open one, cause unknown, with a recommendation that wireless be fitted to all seagoing vessels on the Australian Coast.

Mr. Erskine and myself were subpoenaed by the Commonwealth Government as witnesses on account of the vessel at the time of loss being classed in Lloyd's Register and had recently been under survey.

The enclosed press cutting states the Court's finding.
