Dear Sirs,

With reference to your report No. 7183 on the steamer "BENMACDHUI", I have to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Leith reported last month that the fore peak tank top had been examined and found efficient, and the temporary repairs to the steering engine bedplate examined and a further temporary repair effected. The Surveyors recommended that the steering engine and fore peak tank top should be examined within six months.

It is understood that the vessel has been sold to Mr. Kikujiro Okada of Tokio, and is proceeding to Japan to be broken up.

In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will give the case attention, and advise me immediately the work of demolition has been commenced.
