S. With reference to your letter of the 10th March last in which you stated that arrangements were in progress for the Second Special Survey No.1 of the steamer "ANDROMEDA" ex "HUNTRESS" to be carried out at Rotterdam, I have to inform you that I am in receipt of a communication from the Society's Surveyors at that port in which they state that they have made a few visits with a view to making recommendations for preparing the vessel for survey and sealing the various parts.

As a result of the examination the Society's Surveyors advised the Owners' Representative, and the Master of the vessel who was present, to consult the Owners before undertaking any repairs. The Surveyors understand that the Owners have not yet made a final decision and that it is likely she will be sold.
