I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 6th inst., respecting the S.S. "HUNTRESS", the contents of which I have very carefully noted.


It is with deep regret that I learn of the difficult position in which the Committee were placed, through the issue of my certificate, the two recommendations on which I now see are inconsistent.
