I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 22nd ultimo, confirming your cablegram of the 10th on the subject of the repairs necessary to be carried out to the Steamer "HUNTRESS", and the details mentioned have been carefully noted.

It is concluded from the intimation contained in your cablegram that all the repairs which you consider necessary will be completed to your entire satisfaction before the vessel leaves your port, and on this understanding I may say that the Owners of the vessel have been informed, in reply to a request which has been received by cablegram from Durban, that the Committee will be prepared to agree to the Special Survey No. 1, which becomes due in July next, being postponed until February of next year.

It is noted from your letter that you will arrange to make a general examination of the vessel, and in the meantime action has been deferred pending the receipt of your report on the case.
