In compliance with the request contained in your letter of the 10th instant having further reference to the case of the steamer "HUNTRESS", now named "ANDROMEDA", a cablegram was despatched to the Society's Surveyor at Durban enquiring whether all repairs had been completed to his satisfaction to enable the vessel to carry dry and perishable cargo, and I am today in receipt of his reply in the Society's private code which translated reads as follows :-

"HUNTRESS REPAIRS HAVE BEEN COMPLETED TO MY SATISFACTION  
"TO ENTITLE VESSEL TO RETAIN HER CLASS GLOBAL AND FOR  
"THE CARRIAGE OF DRY AND PERISHABLE CARGO".

I take this opportunity to enclose herewith a form for giving the necessary particulars in connexion with change of ownership which I shall be glad if you will kindly fill in and return to me at once so that the necessary changes may be duly posted in the Register Book.

At the same time I enclose herewith an account for the cost of the cablegrams which have passed between this Office and the Durban Surveyor sent at your request.
