

OWNERSHIP STEEL SCREW STEAMER "HUNTRESS".

In a letter dated 25th August, 1930, which was received in this Office on the 15th September from the South African Railways and Harbours of Johannesburg, it was stated that the above steamer, which was entered in the Register Book as the property of the Administration of the Railways and Harbours, had been sold to foreign buyers for delivery at Durban by the 15th October 1930.

The report of the survey held by the Society's Surveyor at Port Natal on this vessel, dated 30th September, stated that it was understood that negotiations were taking place, with a view to the vessel being sold on the condition that a seaworthy certificate was issued to enable the vessel to proceed with a non-perishable cargo up to 90% deadweight to any destination that did not entail crossing the North Atlantic.
