I was duly favoured with your letter of the 20th instant respecting the S.S. "ANDREAS K.", and beg to acquaint you that the Committee have today had before them a report of survey from the Society's Surveyor at Istanbul on the damage sustained through the vessel stranding in March last.

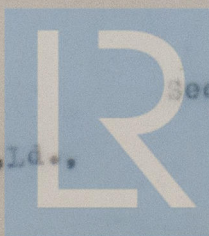
With regard thereto I am directed to inform you that, after consideration of the circumstances they feel that, consistently with the course followed in similar instances, a record of "STRANDED, 3.31 - RELOCATED" should be made against her name in the Register Book.

I may add, however, that in the event of the vessel being repaired to the satisfaction of the Society's surveyors, the notation of casualty will be withdrawn immediately upon reclassification by this Society.
