TYNE MARU.—London, May 2.—The following cable has been received from Tokio, dated May 2: Steamer Tyne Maru reported sunk in collision with steamer KIRIN MARU off Cape Shantung this morning. KIRIN MARU is in ballast, making for Dairen.
—Dairen, May 2.—Japanese steamer KIRIN MARU in collision with Japanese steamer Tyne Maru this morning near Dairen. Latter sank. KIRIN MARU has No. 1 hold flooded.
