The 3rd S.S.No.2 became due 2,35 and a proposal to carry out same within the year of grace has been agreed to.

Permanent repairs require to be effected to stem and stem plating at the Special Survey.

The London Surveyors now report the vessel placed in dock, bottom cleaned ^{Not} and coated and on account of leakage in No.6 double bottom tank port side temporary repairs have been effected to the tank margin which was found to be holed.

The Surveyors recommend permanent repairs be carried out at the Special Survey.

The temporary repairs to stem and stem plating continue to be efficient.

It is submitted action be deferred.
