

As this vessel is intended to trade on the West Coast of Africa the bulk of her cargo carried in the holds will consist of palm oil and kernels. From past experience we have found that these carry better where the tank top is not covered by ceiling and we therefore ask you to be good enough to omit the ceiling in all the holds with the exception of that portion of the tank top which comes in way of the hatches.
