The 2nd Special Survey No 3 became due in July, 1931, & another Special Survey has since become due.

The vessel has been laid up, & the Owners furnished the usual undertaking.

She was recently sold to Messrs Frank Rijpsdyk's Industries, Ltd. of Hendrik-Ido-Ambacht, for breaking up purposes.

The Antwerp Surveyors, in a letter dated 7th December, enclose one received by them from the Owners' Agents, intimating that the vessel will proceed in tow to Dordrecht for breaking up & no survey will be required ^{before} she leaves Antwerp.

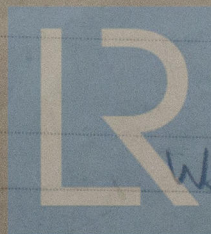
