The 2nd S.S. No.3 became due 7,31 and no part of the Survey has been held.

The vessel being laid up the Owners have furnished the usual undertaking.


The vessel was generally examined in August 1933 and found satisfactory (Special Survey more than 2 years overdue).

The case received consideration in September last (Special Survey more than 3 years overdue), but a further general examination was not then required.

The Antwerp Surveyors wrote on the 3rd instant that the vessel was still laid up.

(Another Special Survey has now become due.)

It is submitted for consideration whether another general examination should now be asked for.
