The class is subject to the outer plates, repaired by electric welding 5,31, being specially examined at the next drydocking.

The 2nd S.S.No.3 became due 7,31 and no part of the survey has been held.

The vessel being laid up, the Owners have furnished the usual undertaking.

The vessel was generally examined in August, 1933, and found satisfactory, the Special Survey being then more than two years' overdue.

In reply to enquiry the Antwerp Surveyors state that the vessel is still laid up.

The year of grace expired 7,32.

It is submitted for the consideration of the Committee whether action might not be deferred.
