Particulars of Casualty

The 2nd Special Survey N°3 became due in July, 1931, + another Special Survey has since become due.

The vessel has been laid up & the Owners furnished the usual undertaking.

She was recently sold to Messrs. Frank Rijdsdijk's Industries, Ltd. of Hendrik-Ido-Ambacht, for breaking up purposes.

The Antwerp Surveyors, in a letter dated 7th December, enclose one received by them from the Owners' Agents, intimating that the vessel will proceed in tow to Dordrecht for breaking up, & no survey will be required before she leaves Antwerp.
