Since writing you on the 3rd instant, respecting the steamers "COMTE DE FLANDRE" and "COMTESSE DE FLANDRE", I have to inform you that notice has appeared in the Shipping Papers here that these two vessels have been sold by the Queen Line Ltd., to Messrs. Frank Rijdsdijk's Industries, Ltd, Hendrik-Ido-Ambacht, to be broken up.
