The class is subject to the rudder main piece, repaired by electric welding 10,29 being specially examined at the next dry docking.


The 2nd S.S.No.3 become due 7,31.


The vessel has been laid up since September 1931 and the usual undertaking has been furnished.


Another Special Survey has since become due.

The Antwerp Surveyors now write stating that the vessel has been sold to the Queen Line, of Glasgow, for breaking up.

It is submitted the Glasgow Office be requested to ascertain at which port the vessel will be broken up, and whether the new Owners desire her to proceed there as a classed ship.
