Action in this case has been deferred from time to time by the Committee in view of the vessel being laid up in Hamburg, and the Owners have agreed to carry out the above surveys before she is recommissioned.

It was recently reported in the Shipping Papers that this vessel was to be broken up, and in reply to inquiry the Hamburg Surveyors state they have been informed by the Owners that until certain financial questions connected with the breaking up of the vessel are settled, a decision as to what will be done cannot be made. They add that it is expected that by the beginning of next month something definite will be known.
