This vessel has been sold to Italian buyers for breaking up, and a general examination of hull and machinery has been carried out by the London Surveyors, and certificates issued for the voyage, as requested.

Messrs. H.E. Moss & Co. (who it is concluded are the Agents for the new Owners) now write stating that the Master of the vessel has taken the certificates to the Italian Consul in London, and has been informed that in consequence of new regulations which have been made, the Surveyors who surveyed the vessel are required to sign a Consular form at the Consulate, 64, Portland Place, W.1. If these Surveyors are not available it will be necessary for a further survey by independent Surveyors to be held. Messrs. Moss & Co. request therefore that the Society's Surveyors might be instructed to attend and sign the necessary form, and they ask that an account for the Surveyors' fees and expenses might be sent to them.

It is submitted Mr. Hudson and Mr. Rae might be instructed to attend at the Italian Consulate, as desired, and that a fee of £3-3-0 might be charged for their services.
