With reference to the 2nd Special Survey No.2 which became due last December on the steamer "PANCRAS" I have to acquaint you that the Owners recently stated that this vessel was being sold for breaking up purposes and the Committee agreed to her proceeding to a coaling port and thence to a Mediterranean port of discharge to be broken up, subject to the hull and engines being generally examined and to the boilers being examined internally, particularly the furnaces of the starboard boiler.

The Society's Surveyors at this port now report that a satisfactory examination has been made, and as it would appear from the Shipping Papers that the steamer has been sold to Italy, I shall be glad if you will give the case attention should she arrive in your district, and notify me immediately the work of demolition has been commenced.
