S. With reference to your letter of the 14th instant and to previous correspondence relating to your steamer "PANCRAS", I have now to inform you that the required inspection has been held by the Society's Surveyors at this port on the vessel whilst lying at the North Woolwich Buoys, and as the result of this examination the Committee, who have had the report before them at their meeting today, are agreeable to the vessel proceeding from this Port to another U.K. port to load a cargo of coal, thence to a Mediterranean port to be broken up on arrival.

The necessary Certificates, in duplicate, have been prepared and are being forwarded by tonight's post to the Society's Liverpool Office to be handed over to you on payment of the fee due for the survey, an account for which I beg to enclose herewith.
